


Golf at Makray Memorial Golf Club 2020

To all who join the 2020 Garlands Golf Club, we will distribute to your purse shelf the extensive list of restrictions* currently placed on Makray so you can determine whether or not you'd like to play (*e.g., be singles or twosomes only; must walk and carry own clubs; no carts, handcarts, or caddies).




Spreading Some Love Tour – A BIG HIT!





Peace in a Storm.

Many years ago, I heard a story about a group of artists who were instructed to paint a picture that illustrated "peace." There were many paintings of quiet streams, grassy meadows, fields of flowers, and the like. The winning painting, however, looked very different from those images. There were dark, ominous storm clouds, bolts of lightning and trees bending in the strong wind. Yet, on one of the branches in one of the trees, there was a bird's next; the mother bird was resting peacefully on her eggs. That's a picture of "peace in a storm."

We've all experienced many types of storms in our lives. It's been said you are either coming out of one, in one now, or there's one just ahead! We are all in a storm right now called COVID-19. The question is, can we be at peace in the midst of this storm? For me, my peace comes from my faith in the Lord. From past storms that I have weathered over the decades, I've come to realize my faith actually grows through the storms.

In Rememberance

A subcommittee of the Member Advisory Committee (MAC) met to revisit and refine procedures for announcing the passing of a Garlands member and to discuss ways to better meet the needs of the spouse and family. The subcommittee requested that The Garlands develop a button on the MyGarlands app that lists the names and dates of member passings from January, 2020, to the present. This list will be continuously updated. The button, entitled In Remembrance, has been implemented and can be identified by the bird (shown above).

We continue to place the announcement of a member's death on the credenza next to the Robie Lounge with a photograph, a candle, a flower, and a tray to hold the obituary and celebration/funeral arrangements of the deceased, depending on the wishes of the surviving spouse or family members. A gold card with the name and date of the member's death, a candle, and the new addition of a tray for the obituary and arrangements, are placed on the credenzas in Buildings 2 and 3, by the mail rooms. Creating the dedicated *In Remembrance* button on the *MyGarlands* app gives members another way to learn of the passing of a Garlands member.

It is the goal of all Garlands staff to treat all member passings with grateful appreciation of members' lives and to respectfully grant the wishes of the bereaved spouse and/or family.

Garlands Author, Dorothy Winsor, Publishes Fourth Young Adult Novel


Post retirement, Dorothy Winsor took up a second career as an author writing young adult fiction. She has published three books and is releasing a new young adult novel, *The Wysman*, this summer. Her advice to others who are considering pursuing new dreams in retirement:

"Don't doubt yourself! Be brave enough to try new things no matter what your age."

A longtime English Professor who taught technical writing at Iowa State University, Winsor says, "Though I read plenty of fiction, I never thought of myself as creative enough to write it." Turns out, she was wrong!

Her soon-to-be released fourth book is about a street kid turned advisor of a king who is determined to hunt down the person who is making poor children disappear. The central character





in The Wysman, and a reoccurring character in Dorothy's books, Jarka, was born with a disability, a crooked foot, and uses a crutch. However, in the world of the book, the gods never take anything away without giving something back. In Jarka's case, although the disability doesn't define the character, the crooked foot is what gives him the ability to read the wind, a key attribute in his quest.

As she developed Jarka's character, Dorothy thought about how disability is something that happens in real life and that "books shouldn't erase it." She reveals, "The Wysman is about the way people who are out of place or who don't easily fit in are sometimes the most perceptive about what's going on around them." It is an important message for her young adult audiences for whom "fitting in" can be a big concern.

Since moving to The Garlands, "fitting in" hasn't been a problem for Dorothy who finds motivation, support and camaraderie with other local writers. "One of the great things I found when we moved to The Garlands was the Barrington Writers Workshop. The Workshop has been meeting for decades, usually in the public library next door to my home at The Garlands. You can't get more convenient than that," she guips.

She also joined two book clubs at The Garlands. "I read all the time on my own, however belonging to the book clubs expanded what I chose to read and showed me how social reading, or really the aftermath of reading, can be," she says. Left to her own, Dorothy reads novels across genres, including fantasy, young adult, mysteries and literary fiction, almost exclusively, but not as much non-fiction, biography or memoir. She says, "My new book clubs have pushed me to change that situation."


